WHEREAS, Georgiana has been a member of the Ko'olauloa Hawaiian Civic Club for most of her life, and while she never held an office, she has supported the club whenever possible; and

WHEREAS, Georgiana was a very compassionate person with a big Hawaiian heart, was loved by her children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews; and

WHEREAS, Georgiana will be remembered by her classmates as the smart, dependable, hardworking, kind, persistent, fun-loving friend.
